During this 14-year term, I was promoted to Senior Director, Vice President, Acting CIO & CSO, and in November of 2015, appointed as Senior Vice President (SVP) and Chief Information Officer (CIO).

As SVP/CIO, I provided leadership to a diverse team of over 650 people, with a combined capital and operational budget in excess of \$200 million. This role provided technology strategic direction and vision for all Shaw companies, contributing to the overall company-wide annual operating plans and business strategy. As the accountable executive for all enterprise-wide user experience, enterprise-wide infrastructure, as well as tier 1 and 2 customer technology operations and support, the role ensured the highest levels of customer experience and satisfaction were achieved. In this role, I drove the Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) strategy and plan, including technology risk, incident and crisis management. In addition, I was accountable for the team providing all security, physical and cyber, and compliance (SOX, PIPEDA, Privacy, CASL etc.), working directly with federal, provincial and local government, and law enforcement agencies.

Over the 14 years, Shaw underwent significant change and transformation as an organization, driven by consumers/customers, competition, regulatory, government, technological and overall industry pressures. In April of 2014, I was given accountability to change the way Shaw operated as a business, which included the significant shift to partner-led and cloud-based business functions and technological solutions.

In December 2001, the Energy Management Group initiated a project to redesign and replace the existing trading and risk management systems with a new energy management system (EMS). As the IS work stream leader, I was responsible for the management of all IS project staff, budget and delivery of the project to satisfy Texas deregulation in early 2002 and the Ontario deregulation in May of 2002. This was a successful project, on time and on budget.

In June of 2002, Direct Energy entered into an agreement to acquire a large customer base in Texas from CPL/WTU. I had a lead role on this project which drove significant IS initiatives around the infrastructure and applications hosted in Calgary.

Throughout 2002 and 2003, I participated in various due diligence exercises conducted by the Mergers & Acquisitions team, most of which were related to corporate or asset-based upstream acquisitions.

In December of 2002, Direct Energy entered into an agreement with ATCO to acquire the 1-million electrical and gas customers in Alberta. As the IS Work Stream Leader for this major initiative, I was responsible for all aspects of the project, including reporting to the executive steering committee. I participated directly in many initiatives and tasks including ATCO I-Tek negotiations, Energy Management Group readiness, regulated and deregulated market entry and office and personnel expansions.

On a continuous basis, I provided valuable input into the development of regional and corporate strategies, processes, and procedures in support of the various business units located throughout Western Canada. As the senior IS representative in Western Canada and member of the Western Region Leadership Team, I provided regular briefings to the regional business managers and executive, while overseeing all project initiatives within Western Canada. I was responsible for the Western Canadian IS capital plan and operating budgets.
