European Studies in Global Perspectives (EUGL)

The EUGL is an international program headed by Carl-von-Ossietzky-Universität in Oldenburg, Lower Saxony, Germany. This program allows students to focus on one of two thematic options, either 'Society, Economy and Politics', or 'Languages, Culture and Education' Structure and Syllabus — Carl von Ossietzky Universität Oldenburg (uol.de). Both of these modules explore the politics and history of the Europe Union through a variety of courses selected by the international student. In addition, almost half the credit comes from a German language course which all international students must take in order to get their certificate. It provides the student with a semester's worth of language credit (equivalent to one course in Canada) and it is taught in German to further immerse students.

My experience studying abroad in Oldenburg was positive for both my academic and personal life. I began the program in March 2019 and it finished in July 2019. Students were expected to plan finances,

housing, transportation and academics all in advance of leaving their home country. Once settled in, I registered for as many social and extracurricular activities as I could, helping to fully engage me in German life and getting to meet new peers from around the world. I took classes in the 'Languages, Culture and Education' module of EUGL, and my German was of a slightly higher level (A1.2) since I had taken a course at the University of Calgary before I left. In addition, I took history and language arts courses as well as a seminar focusing on contemporary German society and immigration.
