As music-making and listening is shaped and experienced with an integration of both mind and body, my research, of which this piece is a part, explores empowering and illuminating this connection. Flutists play while wearing sensors that connects to software that controls propellers to agitate a large container of water. The water sounds are amplified to accompany the flutists, with the aspiration that the piece presents both means and end, process and result, effort and achievement in a struggle of people together against the elements.
